MSA-RIDE RIGHT IN MAINE

- Ride on the right hand side of the groomed trail.
- Ride at a reasonable rate of speed.
- Never drink alcohol and operate a snowmobile.
- Learn and use snowmobiling hand signals.
- Yield to all grooming equipment.
- Wear a helmet and appropriate clothing.
- Carry maintenance and first aid supplies.
- Leave an itinerary of your trip with a responsible person and advise them of any changes or delays.
- Ride defensively. Be alert and expect the unexpected.
- Be absolutely certain of ice thickness if you choose to ride on frozen bodies of water.

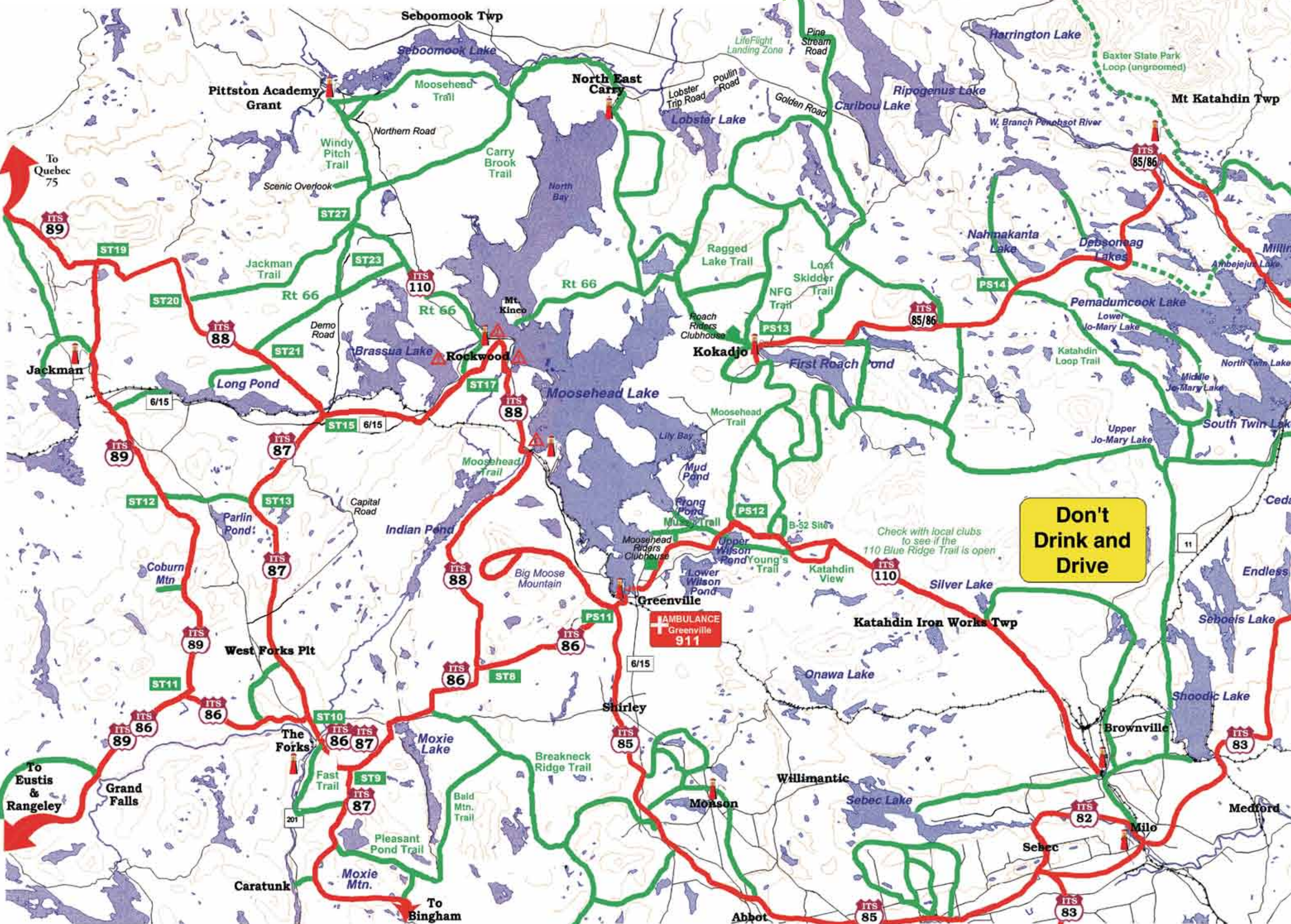

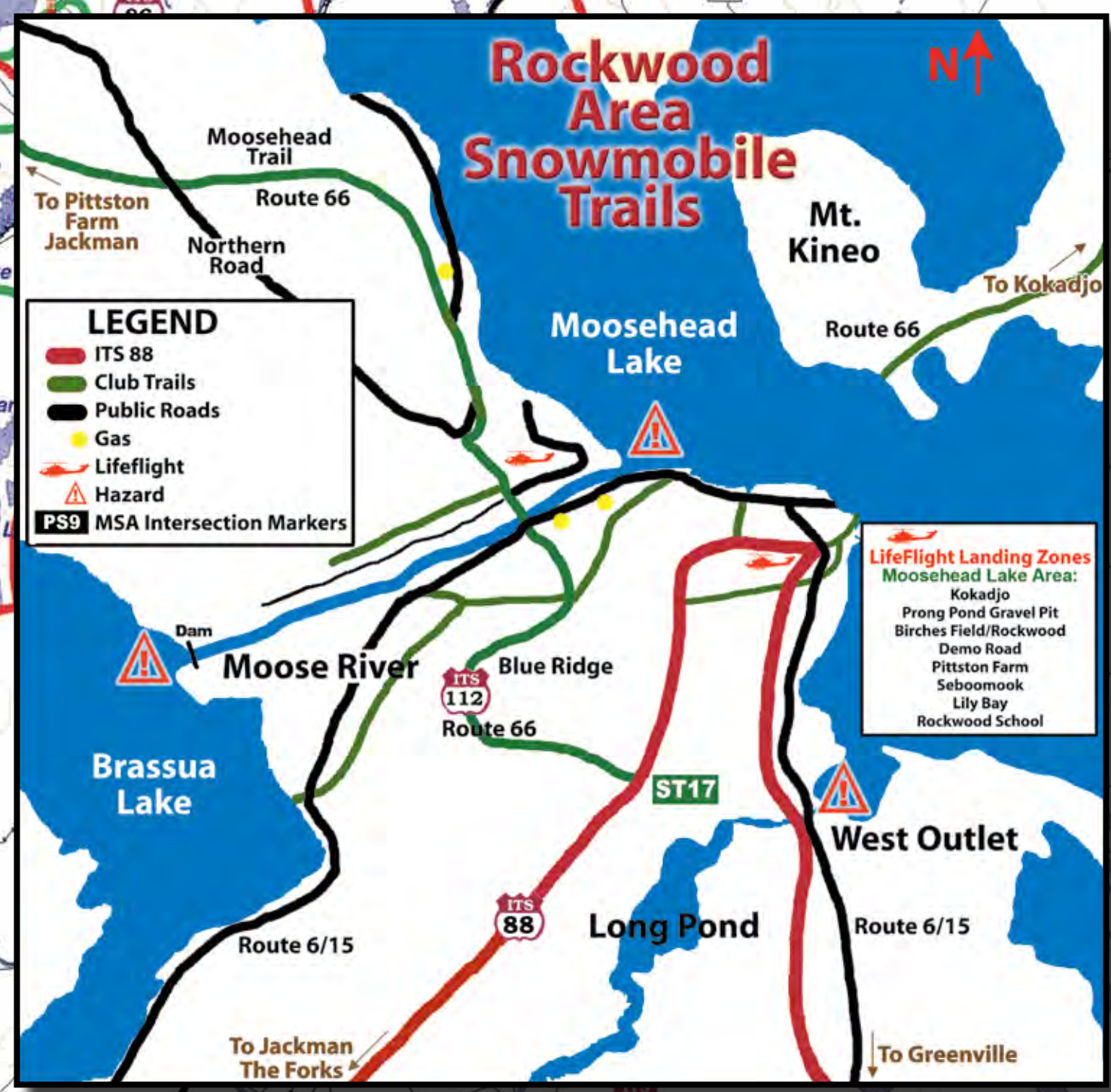
